502.2 Offensive, Insulting or Abusive language:

- 1. One (1) game suspension -- Offensive or insulting or abusive language and/or gestures not directed.
- 2. Three (3) game suspension -- Offensive or insulting or abusive language and/or gestures directed toward a player, referee, assistant referee, administrator, spectator or game and /or tournament official. If the offensive, insulting, or abusive language is reported to be hate speech the penalty shall be increased by two (2) games.
- 3. Six (6) game suspension -- Adult directed to a youth referee.
- 3. Offensive, Insulting or Abusive language towards referees will follow USSF Referee Abuse Prevention (RAP) Policy:
 - a. Two (2) game suspension Level 1: Verbal Taunting (Insulting, Belittling, Insinuating or Taunting Behavior Undermining Referee Authority).
 - b. Four (4) game suspension Level 2: Harassment/Intimidation (Harassment, Intimidation, Retaliation, Abusive, or Threatening Non Physical Language).
 - c. Six (6) game suspension Level 3: Threats/Derogatory Language (Aggression, Attacking, Derogatory, Cyberbullying, Doxing or Threatening Physical / Violence Language).
 - d. Ten (10) game suspension Level 4: Offensive or Discriminatory Act (Discriminatory or derogatory words or actions on account of race, skin color, ethnicity, nationality, social origin, gender, disability, sexual orientation, language, or religion).
 - e. Key penalty factors:
 - 1. Second time offenders receive double punishment.
 - 2. Third time offenders receive a lifetime ban.
 - 3. More than one offense at the same time is at least the punishment for the most serious offense.
 - 4. Offenses against minors are automatically subject to a "minor multiplier" resulting in triple punishment.

4. If the offensive, insulting, or abusive language is reported to be hate speech the penalty shall be increased by two (2) games. – Moved to section 2.
