#### **GAME PREVIEW**

Off a rare loss, Louisville City FC faces a quick turnaround to Wednesday's 7 p.m. kickoff at Indy Eleven, continuing a rivalry series that has become quite contentious over the past year.

When USL Championship clubs returned to play in 2020 amid the COVID-19 pandemic, LouCity got the better of Indy Eleven in a shortened, regionalized season with three wins and a draw. So continued a run of meetings that hadn't resulted in an Indy Eleven win since 2018.

But in 2021, what's known as the Louisville Indianapolis Proximity Association Football Contest took a turn. The series finished 1-1-1, and earlier this season the clubs played to a draw at Lynn Family Stadium.

Both sides can consider themselves motivated to take ahold of the LIPAFC when it resumes at Carroll Stadium.

LouCity (17-4-4, 55 points) enters after a 1-0 weekend defeat at Miami FC. There was no answer offered to a fourth-minute goal, ending the club's 10-game unbeaten streak.

Sitting ninth and unlikely to climb into playoff contention, Indy Eleven (7-14-4, 25 points) showed signs of life last out when ending its four-game losing skid with a 1-0 upset of Western Conference leader San Antonio FC.

#### PLAYOFF PUSH

LouCity's "magic number" is 1 to clinch a spot in the 2022 USL Championship Playoffs. A win or draw Wednesday would make the boys in purple the first club across the league to solidify its spot. Of course, that's a minimum expectation for a club that has advanced to at least the conference final round every year since starting play in 2015.

#### THE FORMAT

LouCity's also trending toward starting the playoffs at home. No. 1 seeds from the East and West receive byes to the conference semifinals. The No. 2-7 clubs open in the conference quarterfinals, with better-seeded teams to host. City would have to slip out of the top four to start the postseason away from Lynn Family Stadium.

### **AVAILABLE FOR SELECTION**

LouCity was shut out last Saturday for just the fifth time this year. That was without leading scorer Wilson Harris in the lineup as he served a onegame suspension stemming from a red card received Aug. 20 at Detroit City FC. Harris has racked up 10 goals so far this season.

#### NO TIME TO REST

Wednesday's game is the second of five in 15 days for LouCity. Four of those are away matchups, with trips to play at FC Tulsa and Pittsburgh Riverhounds SC on tap after City hosts Sacramento Republic FC this Saturday night.

#### **ROAD RECORD**

LouCity played exclusively outside of Louisville during preseason in hopes of improving away. That appears to have worked. Last year, the club went 6-5-5 outside of Lynn Family Stadium. This season, it's 8-3-2 on the road.

#### **TIGHT MARGINS**

It's not often LouCity loses. But when the boys in purple do, they're almost always going to keep the score close. Of five losses this year across all competitions, four were decided by a single goal.

#### **STINGY DEFENSE**

LouCity's 17 goals allowed are five fewer than any other USL Championship club. As a result, goalkeeper Kyle Morton sits in a tie for the league lead in clean sheets with 11. Two more, and he'd tie the club record for shutouts in a season with Greg Ranjitsingh's 2018 mark. The single-season league record for clean sheets is 15.

#### **MILESTONE MEN**

Veteran forward Brian Ownby reached 200 career USL Championship appearances last Saturday against Miami, and defender Oscar Jimenez made it 150 showings. Both players signed with LouCity ahead of the 2017 season, becoming key parts of the club's title runs that year and in 2018.

#### **PLAY THE KIDS**

One bright spot in Saturday's loss was the standout play of two LouCity Academy signings. Carlos Moguel Jr. – a 78th-minute City substitute – produced three shots, two crosses and 100% passing accuracy, including a dipping free kick that forced a save. Elijah Wynder logged 30 minutes after battling injury throughout the 2021 campaign. He recorded 100% passing accuracy and won three fouls, most out of both teams.

### **MILESTONES ON THE HORIZON**

Sean Totsch is three appearances away from 200 USL Championship regular season showings.

#### **MATCH QUOTES**

"We constantly talk about how we have to start the game the right away and switched off for a moment. It happened, and against a team like this that sits back, defends their box and gives you 70% of the ball, you can't concede a chance like that. We get the first goal, and it's a completely different game. All in all, it's not good enough in the back there for the first goal and in the attacking box."

Of that 15 also includes nine of the 11 starters that led the boys in purple to clinching the Central Division title and a trip to City's seventh Eastern Conference Final in as many years as a club.

## HEAD COACH DANNY CRUZ

After three years as the club's top assistant, Danny Cruz was put in charge of the boys in purple when appointed interim head coach on April 27, 2021, before being named permanent head coach on Oct. 11 that same year.

Cruz made an immediate impact upon joining the club as a full-time assistant in September of 2018, seeing LouCity win its second straight

USL Championship Final, the first club in league history to do such a feat.

In his time with LouCity, Cruz has gone on to further establish a challenging style of play for the boys in purple, playing out of the back with double-digit passing sequences known to confound opposing squads.

Cruz played professional soccer from his 2009 MLS SuperDraft selection until he joined the Real Monarch SLC in 2018 as an assistant coach. Over the course of his pro career, Cruz registered 137 Major League Soccer appearances including time with the Houston Dynamo, D.C. United and the Philadelphia Union. Cruz was a starter on the 2011 Houston Dynamo squad which squared off against the David Beckham and Landon Donovan-led L.A. Galaxy team in the 2011 MLS Cup.

## SIMON BIRD ASSISTANT COACH

The Lincoln, England, native was a star at the University of Louisville

from 2001-04, earning Conference USA Player of the Year in 2003, and had a six-year professional career in England before returning as a University of Louisville Assistant Coach from 2009-12. A fixture on the local soccer scene, Bird has worked as Oldham Soccer Club's

Director of Coaching and Kentucky Fire Juniors Boys Director. Bird holds an A License from the U.S. Soccer Federation and is a Qualified Teacher for High School Physical Education and Sports Science.

## SCOTT BUDNICK

**GOALKEEPERS COACH** 

With a steady hand and his keen eye for technical detail, Scott Budnick was brought in by LouCity coach John Hackworth in August of 2018 as interim goalkeepers coach, helping lead the boys in purple to winning the club's second-straight USL Championship title.

Budnick's role was made permanent after that, with a top accomplishment his tutelage of FC Cincinnati loanee Ben Lundt, who spent two seasons in purple, capping his stay by being named the USL Championship's 2020 Goalkeeper of the Year.


